A Health & Traceability Revolution for Tanzania's Livestock Sector.

On June 16, 2025, President Dr. Samia Suluhu Hassan launched a landmark five-year campaign to vaccinate over 76 million animals, equip livestock with electronic ear tags, and unlock international markets — backed by TZS 216 billion in Government funding.

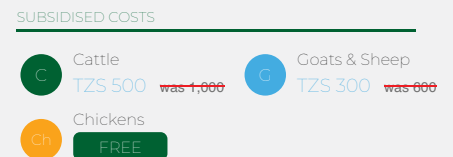
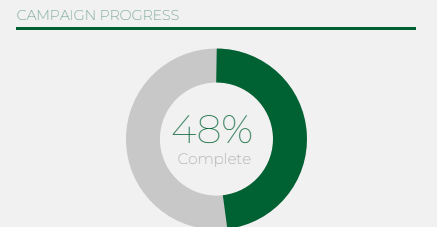
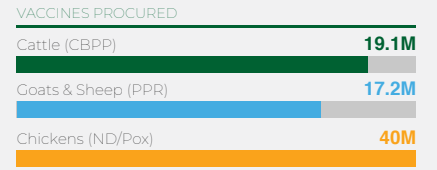
Since assuming office in March 2021, President Dr. Samia Suluhu Hassan has elevated the livestock sector as a pillar of Tanzania's economic transformation. With the formal launch at Nyakabindi Grounds, Bariadi District, the Government committed TZS 216 billion over five years — and TZS 28.1 billion for the 2024/2025 financial year alone — to revolutionise animal health and traceability.

The campaign targets 19,099,100 cattle against Contagious Bovine Pleuropneumonia (CBPP), 17,224,200 goats and sheep against Peste des Petits Ruminants (PPR), and 40 million indigenous chickens against Newcastle Disease, fowl pox, and avian influenza — the latter entirely free of charge. The Government also distributed 700 motorcycles and 4,500 tablets to field extension officers.

Electronic ear tags represent a paradigm shift: Tanzania will move from population estimates to a verified national livestock database — essential for compliance with WOA, FAO, and WTO standards. Countries including Egypt and the UAE are already prepared to begin purchasing live Tanzanian animals, Minister Dr. Ashatu Kijaji conducted field inspection tours opening major new export revenues for the country. Across eight regions urging farmers to utilise the subsidy and warning professionals against unauthorised charges. By end of August 2025, 36.74 million animals had been vaccinated — 48.13% of the national target — a remarkable opening milestone.





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KIGOMA CASSAVA AGRONOMY INITIATIVE (KCAI)

Executive Summary

KCAI was established in 2024 to break a devastating economic paradox: although Kigoma is the heartbeat of Tanzania's cassava production, its 1.9 million stakeholders remain trapped in a cycle of subsistence farming. Currently, the regional value chain is crippled by a 'productivity gap' averaging only 3.5 to 8.5 tons per hectare. KCAI intervenes to bridge this gap, transforming cassava from a survival crop into a climate resilient industrial powerhouse for the entire Great Lakes region.

The Vision: From Food Security to Agro-Industrialization

KCAI moves beyond traditional NGO models by viewing cassava as an industrial powerhouse for textiles, pharmaceuticals, and bioethanol. Our mission is to bridge the gap between raw production and high-value processing, turning a primary crop into a driver for regional economic stability.



Our Five Strategic Pillars

- 1. Productivity & Climate-Smart Agriculture:** Introducing high-yield, disease resistant varieties and regenerative techniques to triple current output.
- 2. Advocacy & Trade Facilitation:** Serving as a diplomatic bridge to align local production with EAC, SADC, AU and Global standards for international market access.
- 3. Value Addition & Technology:** Transitioning from raw exports to industrial processing hubs for high-quality flour and industrial starch.
- 4. Financial Inclusion & Data Systems:** Building digital identities for farmers to make them "bankable" and ready for industrial capital.
- 5. Socio-Economic Impact:** Measuring success through the holistic development of stakeholders translating "crop yield" into "human yield."

The 2026 Roadmap: Institutional Sustainability

KCAI is redefining the Tanzanian NGO landscape through a Social Enterprise Model. By establishing a commercial arm, we are moving away from donor dependency toward long-term financial independence.

Key 2026 Milestones:

- **10-Hectare Pilot Model:** A precision-engineered "Proof of Concept" to demonstrate high-yield technology and regenerative agronomy.
- **Resource Mobilization:** Partnering with investors to deploy industrial capital.

The call came in 2019. Stanbic Bank Tanzania was looking for someone to lead its investment banking franchise — not merely to manage transactions, but to architect a vision. They found their man in Elibariki Ndossi.

It was a natural fit. By that point, Ndossi had already spent more than a decade at NBC Limited — the institution formerly part of the ABSA and Barclays empire — building a reputation as one of Tanzania's most formidable bankers. He had climbed through senior leadership with uncommon speed, eventually heading both Large Local Corporates and Corporate Debt, portfolios that placed him at the negotiating table for some of the country's most consequential financing deals.

“Banking is not about spreadsheets,” he once told a gathering of emerging finance professionals at the University of Dar es Salaam. “It is about understanding what a country needs — and having the courage and craft to help it get there.”

That philosophy was put to work at Stanbic, where Ndossi led a portfolio that swelled to nearly USD 700 million. His mandate stretched across the full spectrum of Tanzania's economy: government and sovereign transactions, infrastructure and energy, real estate, mining, telecommunications — and capital markets, which would become his defining stage.

It was in capital markets where Ndossi would leave his most visible mark. Under his stewardship, Stanbic Tanzania executed what remains Tanzania's largest green bond issuance — a milestone that signalled to the world that East African capital markets could attract ESG mandates at scale.

The transaction was years in the making. “It required alignment between the issuer, the regulators, international investors, and local institutional buyers,” recalls a colleague who worked alongside him. “Elibariki held all of that together — calmly, methodically.”

Governance was never an afterthought. Throughout his tenure at Stanbic, Ndossi insisted on what insiders call a “risk-first” culture — one that priced in political risk, currency volatility, and sector concentration with the same rigor applied to financial modelling.

This disposition earned him the Certified Director designation (CiDir), a credential typically reserved for those who can demonstrate not just technical competence, but institutional wisdom. He holds additional certifications in finance, investment advisory, and leadership — complemented by academic credentials from the University of Dar es Salaam, UCT Graduate School of Business, and the Gordon Institute of Business Science.

SECTOR EXPERTISE



Now, as Chief Executive Officer, Ndossi carries that synthesis of technical depth and institutional gravitas into an abroader mandate. His appointment marks not just a change of title, but a change of scale: from deal-maker to institution-builder.

Beyond the boardroom, he invests significant time as an instructor and mentor within Tanzania's financial and business community — working with young professionals who, like him a generation ago, are trying to decode the grammar of capital in a fast-moving market.

When the Mountain Fell on Hanang

How 415 Tanzania Red Cross volunteers answered the call — turning catastrophe into a story of shelter, solidarity, and survival.

89+ Lives lost

It began, as disasters so often do, with rain. In December 2023, the hills of Hanang District in the Manyara Region of northern Tanzania had been saturated for days when the earth finally gave way. The landslide that followed killed over 89 people and displaced approximately 44,000 — one of Tanzania's most devastating natural disasters in recent memory.

Within hours, the Tanzania Red Cross Society (TRCS) was moving. Part of the global International Red Cross and Red Crescent Movement, TRCS activated its national volunteer network with uncommon speed — mobilising 415 volunteers for search and rescue operations, damage assessment, and the establishment of displacement camps.

Our volunteers did not wait for instructions to begin, they were already on the ground before dawn.”

said a TRCS spokesperson.

The logistical scale of the response was significant: blankets, clothing, and hygiene kits were distributed to displaced families; water trucking and sanitation infrastructure were established; food parcels reached the most vulnerable within the first 72 hours.

The sheltering phase of the response became one of TRCS's most ambitious construction efforts. In partnership with the International Federation of Red Cross and Red Crescent Societies (IFRC), the organisation funded and oversaw the construction of 35 permanent homes for landslide victims — each built to standards designed to withstand future climate-related events.

The homes represent the beginning of something, not the end. Of the 109 families originally displaced, 35 now have permanent shelter. The remaining 74 remain a priority for future phases of reconstruction — a reminder that the humanitarian mission in Hanang is ongoing.

Central to the recovery effort is the European Union, whose humanitarian arm provided a €100,000 aid package specifically targeting the Hanang response. The EU funding was channelled through TRCS to cover food security, water and sanitation, hygiene, shelter rehabilitation, health services, and protection for the most vulnerable — including women, children, and the elderly.

TRCS operates on four interconnected pillars that the Hanang response illustrates in full: disaster response and emergency relief; health services spanning blood donation to refugee camp support; community development around WASH programming; and youth engagement, through which hundreds of young Tanzanians serve as the frontline of the Red Cross movement.

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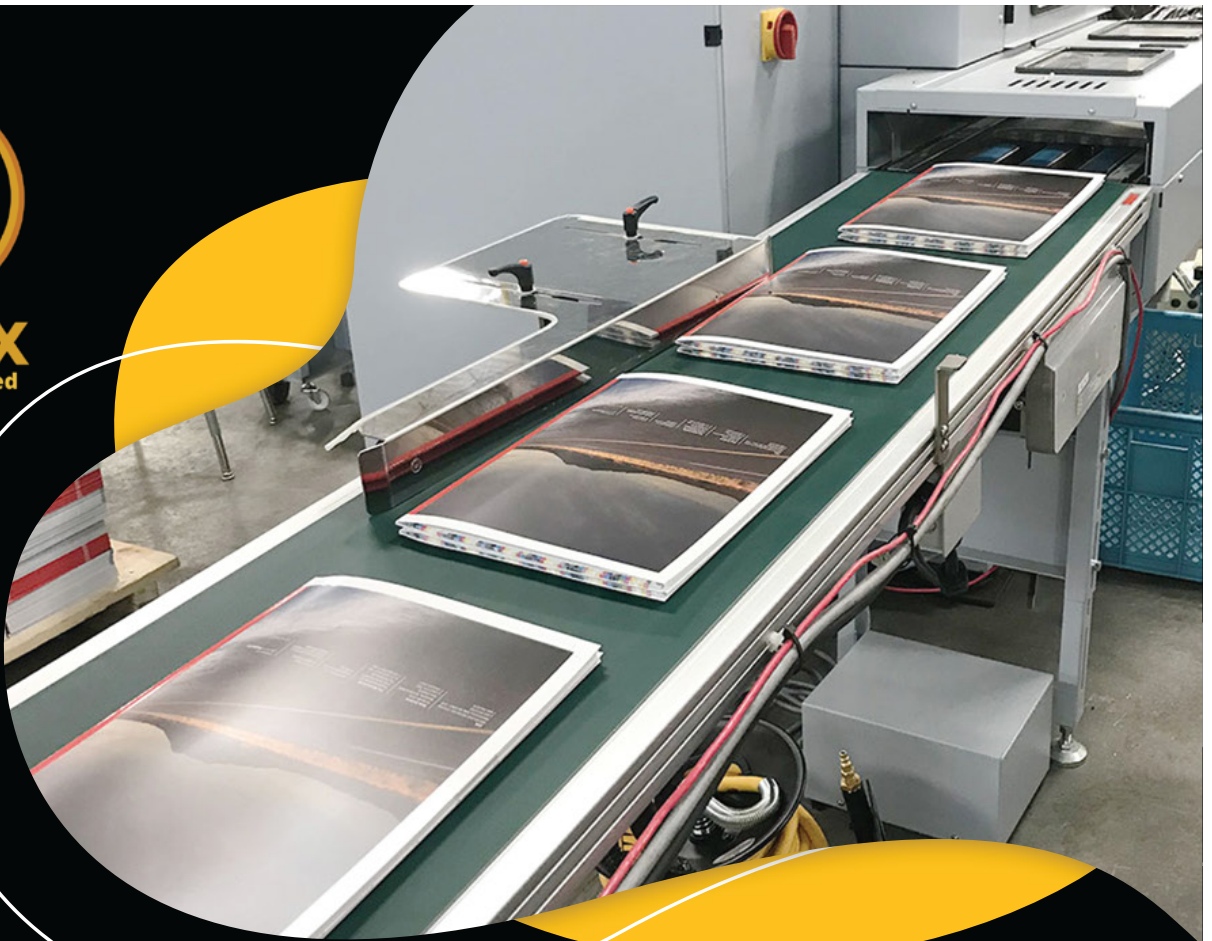

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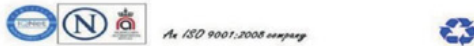

Harvesting the Ocean's Promise.

How Zanzibar Seaweeds Company Limited is transforming a humble coastal crop into a global blue economy powerhouse — rewriting the futures of thousands of island farmers.

When Zanzibar's coastal women wade into the warm shallows each morning to tend their seaweed lines, they are doing something their mothers did — but the value that flows from those same tidal flats is changing beyond recognition.

Zanzibar Seaweeds Company Limited — ZASCO — is the institution engineered to capture that transformation. Registered on 17 January 2022 under the Companies Act No. 15 of 2013, this Government-owned enterprise operates across both Unguja and Pemba islands, sitting at the intersection of coastal livelihoods, industrial processing, and the global market for carrageenan — the seaweed-derived compound that appears in everything from infant formula to pharmaceutical gels.

The statistics tell their own story. Zanzibar once produced upwards of 12,000 tonnes of dry seaweed annually, making it one of East Africa's principal exporters. But for decades, the product left the islands as raw biomass — unprocessed, undervalued, generating minimal revenue. ZASCO's mandate is to reverse that equation entirely.

The carrageenan opportunity is the centerpiece of that vision. Extracted from Kappaphycus and Eucheuma seaweed species — both abundantly farmed in Zanzibar — carrageenan commands premium prices in food, cosmetics, and pharmaceutical markets globally. ZASCO's processing infrastructure is designed to capture that margin domestically rather than surrendering it to overseas refiners.

The company's reach extends beyond processing. Through SME empowerment programmes and community development initiatives, ZASCO is building the institutional scaffolding for a genuine blue economy ecosystem — one where farmers, processors, researchers, and market developers are connected in a single, resilient value chain.

The Company was incorporated on February 2016 with the aim of developing Gold Mining projects, trading, Processing and Refining of Gold.



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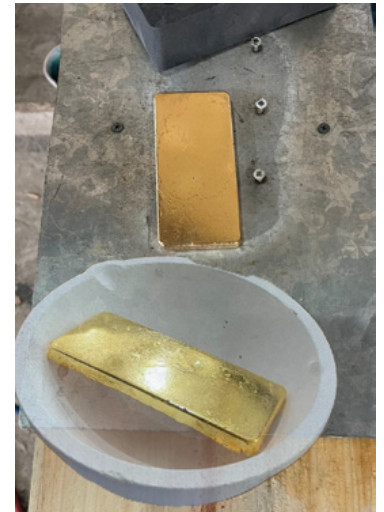
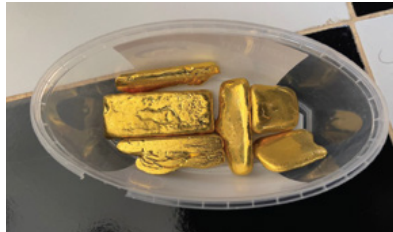
Elution is a process of recovering Gold by Electrowinning process, In this process, after the VAT leaching, the clients bring their loaded carbon consisting of Gold.

The loaded carbon is placed in the elution column mixed with water and some chemicals, electricity is passed through the column by heating making the Gold to desorb from the carbon thus dissolving with chemicals present in the solution mixture forming Gold solution, again the electric current is passed through cathode and anode allowing Gold to get Electroplated to the Cathode which is used as steel wire.

After 24 hours the Cathode is taken out and subjected to Aqua-Regia digestion by separating Gold concentrates and other impurities.

After smelting Gold concentrates Raw Gold is formed. At our Elution Site, we are planning for 10 Elution columns, each column can load up to 500 kgs of carbon at high pressure with 24 hours cycle time, this can serve all the clients to get maximum recovery of Gold by satisfying their needs.

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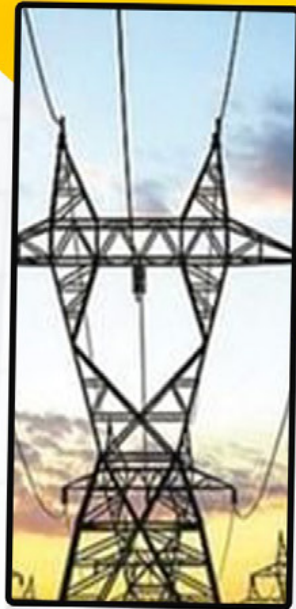

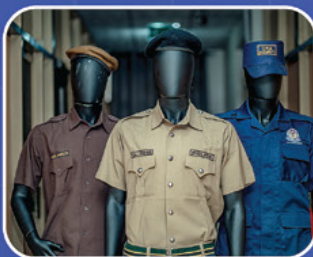

Zanzibar's Blue Horizon: Why the Ocean Is the Island's Future

Few places in the world are as intrinsically tied to the ocean as Zanzibar. An archipelagic nation made up of the two main islands of Unguja and Pemba, alongside 53 smaller islets, Zanzibar covers just 2,654 square kilometers of land—yet it is embraced by nearly 220 kilometers of coastline and a vast ocean estate that defines its past, present, and future.

Located about 50 kilometers off the mainland Tanzania and forming part of the United Republic of Tanzania, Zanzibar shares an Exclusive Economic Zone (EEZ) of more than 223,000 square kilometers with the Mainland Tanzania. This marine space, almost 88 times larger than Zanzibar's landmass, is the foundation of the island's Blue Economy: *a bold development pathway that places the ocean at the center of inclusive and sustainable growth.*

People of the Coast

Zanzibar's population reached approximately 1.9 million in 2022 and continues to grow at an annual rate of 3.7%. Women make up 51.6% of the population, while men account for 48.4%. Crucially, the island is young and dynamic: around 58% of Zanzibaris are of working age (15–64), and an impressive 74.4% of the workforce is youth aged 15–34. This demographic dividend offers a powerful engine for current and future economic transformation.

Life in Zanzibar is closely woven into the shoreline. Nearly two-thirds of the population lives within one kilometer of the coast, relying on artisanal fisheries, aquaculture, particularly seaweed and sea cucumber farming, tourism, and small-scale agriculture. For women and youth especially, these ocean-based sectors are not just economic activities; they are lifelines.

The Blue Economy as a National Vision

Zanzibar has adopted the Blue Economy as its flagship socio-economic agenda, with an ambitious goal: *to become an upper-middle-income economy by 2050.* At its core, the Blue Economy is about unlocking ocean wealth in ways that reduce poverty, create jobs, and attract large-scale investment—without compromising environmental integrity.

In 2024, already, blue economy sectors contribute an estimated 42.2% of Zanzibar's GDP and employ about 43% of the working-age population. With targeted policies and strategic investment, these figures are expected to rise significantly with an estimated of GDP contribution of 60% by 2026, positioning Zanzibar as a leading ocean-based economy in the Western Indian Ocean.

Priority Sectors Driving the Blue Economy

Zanzibar's Blue Economy policy focuses on five interlinked priority areas:

- *Fisheries and Aquaculture* – from artisanal and deep-sea fisheries to seaweed and sea cucumber farming, supported by value addition and processing.
- *Sustainable Tourism* – capitalizing on the island's "sea and sun" appeal, rich history, and unique natural attractions.
- *Energy* – including renewable energy, as well as oil and gas exploration.
- *Maritime Trade, Transport, and Marine Infrastructure* – strengthening ports, shipping, and logistics.
- *Blue Economy Governance* – ensuring strong ocean governance, policy coherence, and sustainable resource management.

Together, these sectors aim to generate inclusive growth while safeguarding the marine ecosystems that underpin them.



What we offer

Zanzibar presents highly attractive opportunities across several strategic blue economy sectors. Investments in deep-sea fishing and seaweed value chains, including value-addition activities, are among the most lucrative. With a deep-sea fishing port under construction and significantly improved cold-chain infrastructure, we invite partners to collaborate in this growing sector.

In tourism, Zanzibar recorded nearly one million tourist arrivals in 2025. This growth creates strong demand for additional tourism infrastructure, including high-end resorts, MICE facilities, and supporting logistics such as a dedicated cruise ship terminal.

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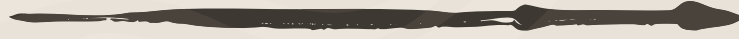

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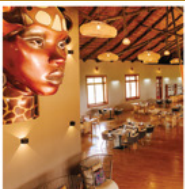
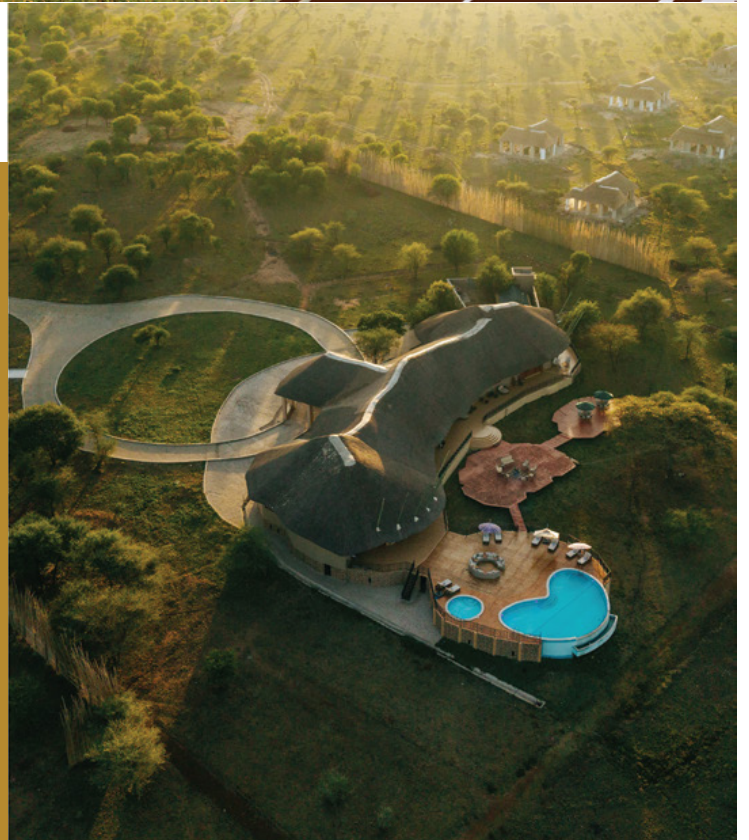

Dar Port's Five-Month Jump Shifts Focus to Clearance Efficiency, Evacuation Capacity and Predictability

A port's reputation gets built in the places most people never see. During phone calls between a clearing agent and a customer, the agent inquires about when the cargo will be loaded. In a transporter's decision to accept another job because the last truck turned around on time. In a factory, a manager's confidence that an input will arrive before production stops. That is the real audience for Dar es Salaam's recent surge in volumes, and the real test for the port's next phase.

TPA operational data shows Dar handled 13.97 million tonnes from July to November 2025, compared with 10.40 million tonnes in the same months of 2024. FY 2024/25 closed at 27.7 million tonnes, up from 23.7 million tonnes in the previous year, a 15 per cent increase and the highest annual throughput recorded. Numbers like these bring pride, but they also bring pressure. Every tonne adds work to the yards, the gates, and the clearance chain. When the system works, the region feels it through lower friction. When it strains, the region feels it through delays and cost.

Dar's answer begins with the capacity that affects vessel calls directly. The entrance channel and berths have been deepened to 14.5 metres under the Dar es Salaam Maritime Gateway Project, allowing larger ships to dock with heavier loads. That change ties into a time claim that has attracted attention among logistics players. Average container vessel time in port has fallen from about 10 days to about three days. A week saved on the ship side helps carriers protect schedules and helps cargo owners reduce exposure to time-related charges.

Bulk cargo handling adds another layer of evidence. Some grain vessels are now reported to offload 65,000 tonnes per call compared with around 15,000 tonnes previously. That shift matters for national supply chains and regional import cycles. It suggests a port that can process larger volumes per vessel call. It also increases the need for strong inland evacuation, because intense discharge sends more cargo into the system faster.

TPA Director General Plasduce Mbossa describes the port's goal as a chain-wide discipline, not a waterfront-only story. "A port succeeds when the whole chain moves," Mbossa said. "Working a vessel fast helps, but the customer experiences the port through clearance and evacuation. Our job stays on removing time from the chain end to end."

Operationally, Dar now runs a split terminal structure. DP World manages berths 0 to 7 under a performance-based arrangement. The container terminal, berths 8 to 11, is operated by Tanzania East Africa Gateway Terminal Limited. The structure matters because execution depends on daily decisions, berth planning, equipment uptime, maintenance routines, and yard management. Public investment in cranes and ICT systems supports the operators, while performance-based management sharpens expectations for productivity and consistency.

For the shipping side, a key move has been the implementation of Fixed Berthing Windows. Fixed Berthing Windows provides shipping lines with assured, predefined berthing windows. It rewards discipline on both sides. Carriers gain

more certainty in when a vessel will be served. Terminals gain steadier planning and fewer last-minute disruptions. For cargo owners, the benefit comes indirectly through improved schedule integrity, which makes downstream planning easier for forwarders, transporters, and warehouses.

Mbossa frames the reform in customer language. "Predictability sits at the centre of competitiveness," he said. "When berthing becomes predictable, the rest of the chain can be planned. Planning reduces panic. Planning reduces cost."

Mbossa argues that inland evacuation decides the quality of the port experience. "When cargo gets out quickly, everyone wins," he said. "The ship gets served, the yard stays manageable, trucks rotate faster, and the importer receives goods sooner. Kwala supports that flow, and we will keep strengthening the link between the seaport and inland logistics."

The next phase combines expansion and coordination. TPA is targeting a throughput of around 30 million tonnes by 2030, supported by adding 10 new berths and automation investments. The port authority is also working with border agencies to speed up customs clearances and with truckers to alleviate hinterland bottlenecks. Improved rail connectivity remains central to strengthening the port's role as a regional gateway, because evacuation capacity determines whether time savings at berth translate into time savings for cargo owners.

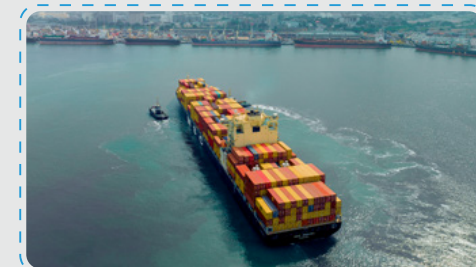
Bagamoyo sits on the longer horizon as a complementary project, revived as part of a sequenced expansion approach. TPA's position emphasises pragmatism and staging to align future capacity with demand growth and avoid overcapacity, while Dar continues to build reliability through operational reform, infrastructure upgrades, and inland logistics.

For the logistics market, Dar's story now reads as a promise with measurable consequences. The port has raised throughput sharply in five months. It has paired that with deeper berths, faster vessel service claims, planned berthing windows, and a large inland depot strategy. The judgment will come from whether clearance and evacuation keep pace. If the chain stays predictable as volume rises, traders feel it in fewer surprises, tighter delivery timelines, and a gradual reduction in the hidden costs of waiting.



Even with strong berthing discipline, most delay pain for traders often comes after discharge. Containers dwell too long when clearance cycles slow or when evacuation cannot keep pace with arrivals. Dar's strategy responds by pushing capacity inland through the Kwala Inland Container Depot, linked by rail. Kwala aims to free quay space and keep the port fluid during seasonal peaks or heavy rains, while shifting handling and storage away from the waterfront.

TPA has described Kwala at a scale that signals intent. The depot sits on 502 hectares and is expected to handle and store about 3,500 containers per day and more than 300,000 containers per year, around 30 per cent of containers moving through Dar es Salaam. The numbers matter because they show a lever that can protect the seaport from yard saturation. They also give the market a way to judge whether the inland plan matches the waterfront gains.





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
